

Crime Track

The purpose of this system is to provide a connection directly between commercial businesses, community groups, Law Enforcement and the Near Northwest Management District to help serve these entities with public safety issues addressing criminal activity through partnerships.

This system is set up as both a commercial business and Community group's security site. The system is provided by the Near Northwest Management District for the purpose of supplementing public safety issues within the management districts boundaries. Those boundaries can be viewed by logging onto the district web site www.nearnorthwestdistrict.org.

The system operates by way of an approved individual representing a business or community group to the management district. This individual must supply their name, date of birth, social security number and driver's license number to (Law Enforcement) through the management districts contracted constable Deputy Sergeant. A release form is provided for this purpose through the Management District.

The Sergeant will complete a criminal background on the approved individual to ensure this person does not have a criminal history or outstanding warrants for their arrest. All confidential information will be handled and kept by Law Enforcement only and not the Management District. Subsequent to an acceptable background check completion the approved individual will be issued a pass word to utilize the "Crime Track" system. Every individual who is issued a pass word will be approved by the Executive Director of the Management District.

Immediately subsequent to the individual receiving a pass word they can then begin to enter incident reports into the Crime Track system. The system is monitored daily but not instantly by the district and constable deputies. The districts contracted Deputy Sergeant will follow up on all incident reports entered into the system. If there is no return contact to the person entering the incident report within two days or within one day following a week end the district encourages that person to contact the district as soon as possible.

The process is simple, enter a description of a particular criminal activity/incident report as instructed through the district security meeting you attended and the constable deputies and the district will do the rest to include providing you further instructions should that be a necessity.
