Endowed Scholarship Information

The Foundations offer an endowed scholarship program that allows individuals, businesses, and community organizations to establish endowments for the purpose of providing scholarships for students of the Lone Star College System.

These endowed scholarships are in the donor's names and create a perpetual fund to award annual scholarships.

The Greater Inwood Partnership currently has two fully-funded endowed scholarships and they are working to fund a third.

This third endowment will benefit Aldine ISD graduating seniors attending a Lone Star College campus when it is fully-funded. Students will receive assistance for tuition, fees, and other expenses. The investment will change these students' lives, allowing them to receive the education and training needed to either prepare them for further education or to secure a quality job in our community.
